New Lake Toy? Keep up with the Paperwork



Don't lose precious time on the water because of paperwork. A boat, vessel, or documented vessel registration must be renewed every three years and there is no late renewal penalty. Outboard motor decals are not required to be renewed.

If you're in the area and need to visit the license office, head over to the Camdenton License Office at 108 Cecil St., Book an appointment at molicense.com.

In need of a new decal or MO numbers for your boat? Check out Instant Signs & Banners in Lake Ozark. Save time and have Riggs Request pickup and deliver the new decals for you.



MAIL FORWARDING: Although mail forwarding may begin within 3 business days of your submitted request, it's best to allow up to 2 weeks. Submit a temporary change-of-address request so you can receive your mail while you're away for 15 days and up to 1 year.

Opening your lake home for the summer is just as time consuming as turning it down for the long winter. Beat the rush and schedule essential and non-essential services early.

2 Are you keeping track of your lake home inventory? We recommend our clients maintain a Lake Home Inventory Log of valued property. This log can assist with identifying potential losses, and help you maintain a more organized lake life. Evaluate and adjust your Lake Home Inventory at the beginning and end of each season.

Riggs Request includes this service with all Property Summerization and Winterization bookings.

3 Due for a trim? Arrange to have any large branches trimmed back and removed from the property as needed.

4 Prepare your AC for the upcoming season: Spring Checks are an essential part of keeping your system running smoothly and finding issues before they become

summer problems. We spoke with Becky Moos, one of the owners of Kal's. She let us know maintenance is determined by the weather and it must be 65-70 degrees outside to properly perform the check. Once the area hits these temps, Kal's will book your service call within a couple of days or at most within one week, depending on weather & demand. Kal's recommends two checks per year, During the Spring check, they conduct a thorough inspection of your units to ensure everything is running properly, replacing refrigerant if it has run out or is low, checking evaporator coils and cleaning if needed, checking capacitor(s) and replacing if weak or damaged, checking & clearing

Pro-Tips

Thermostats and Smoke Alarms should be completely replaced every 10 years & Carbon Monoxide Detectors should be completely replaced every 5-7 years. Replace batteries in Smoke Alarms & Carbon Monoxide Detectors every 6 months. Most digital thermostats are hard wired to your home and likely have backup batteries. Replace the backup batteries in your thermostat once a year.

The worst is getting to the lake without the essentials. Remember to bring all necessary tools, keys and documents, such as boat registration and MO numbers.

Pest Control



Check areas that have been left undisturbed for the

winter. Check items like towels, beds, etc., for any type of insect that may have moved in over the winter.

Check around windows, doors, etc., to see if any type of gap exists that happened with the weather or a critter trying to get in. Lots of people don't realize how many animals get stuck in a chimney, or attic over the winter trying to stay warm.

Remove any leaves and debris away from the home as these are great harborages for insects to breed and hide out. Wood piles are another example. Trimming of any trees that hang over the house is recommended as this will make it harder for the critters to get to the house.





You want to see the lake when you're here, not dirty windows. Cleaning your windows can be a huge undertaking, especially if you have hard to reach places and high ceilings in your home. Your deck, docks and other outdoor areas need some TLC from time to time as well.

Vibrant Lake Ozark recommends booking your Spring cleaning now for all your window washing and power washing needs.

As soon as the pollen drops in the area, bookings will be accommodated on a first come first serve basis and we know you want your home ready before Memorial Day. Pollen typically drops around the end of April but can vary year to year. In terms of frequency, they also recommend having your windows cleaned twice a year - once in the Spring and again in the Fall.

Clean Your Bottom!

Nothing says, "I'm ready for the lake" like a boat so clean, it looks like it just rolled off the lot. Here is what you need to know from Darin at Sunny's Marina.

When we spoke with Darin, he recommended having your boat bottom painted every two – three years and he strongly encourages you buff and wax at that time as well. If you don't, you will risk losing the pigments in the paint as the gelcoat is very porous. The more porous it becomes, the harder it will be to clean in the future.

Sunny's Marina recommends booking one – two months out from your preferred completion date. Once you deliver your boat to the marina, it will take approximately one week (or up to a week and a half) to complete the buff, wax, and paint job.

New docks can take up to 9 months to receive. In the meantime, here is some helpful information on maintaining the one you have now.

We spoke with LD Schlobohm, Operations Manager at DockWorks on the 3mm. He gave us the following recommendations when checking on your dock.

Ensure your cables are tight enough, but not too tight. Be sure you're checking all of the cables and the connections. Cables were likely loosened for the winter draw down of the lake and will now need to be adjusted and tightened for the summer season.

Inspect the roof of the dock. If it was a snowy winter and your dock roof doesn't have a slant, you could find damage.


Check the entire dock for broken bolts.

Check on your floats to make sure they are not damaged.

Floats can sometimes be punctured or even sink if there was any ice around your dock this past winter.

3 Lake Life Home Design Looks for Summer

1) Nature Inspires with Biophilic Design (I know, it sounds really serious but it's actually not)

Biophilic design integrates natural materials and elements into the home which can have a positive impact on our overall mood, health, and well-being. Lake of the Ozarks is the perfect backdrop to inspire this way of living:

- Introduce natural materials. For example, a tree bark accent wall, stone coffee table, and plants (real or quality faux work just fine).
- Use organic, curvy shapes like cocooning furniture, arches, and sculptural accent pieces.
- Incorporate earthy color tones such as green, shades of brown, and dusty blue.



2) Statement Walls & Art

Does anyone have a "Go Jump in the Lake" sign on their wall? A lot of my clients feel overwhelmed by blank walls so they either ignore them or throw up some generic signs which can make the room feel flat and uninteresting. Here are a few tips:

- Invest in art you love: Make it an adventure! Go to flea markets, seek out local artists (one of my favorites is DianeBooneStudio.com shown in the mood board above), or blow up black and white pictures of your kids jumping in the lake. Original art has the power to evoke feeling when you walk into a space and you can pass special pieces on to future generations.
- Make an impact with wallpaper! These products are a great way to create a wow moment.
- Get creative with millwork wall treatments: board and batten, wainscoting, modern wood tiles ... there are so many options to create interest.

3) Mix Design Styles

Trends, by definition, come and go which can be frustrating and costly if you go all in. By mixing design styles you can achieve a more timeless look.

- Define your style: Use your primary style for large, foundational, or more pricey items. Layer in accent pieces (pillows, rugs, decor, etc.) that align with your secondary style or hot trends these are easier to change over time.
- Create juxtaposition: this gets a little more technical but it helps create
 contrast which is key. In the first mood board above, I've balanced a warm
 modern style with some touches of traditional.
- Follow the 70/30 rule: To keep things simple and avoid a messy or an
 unintentional look, design with 70% in your primary style and 30% in your
 secondary or trend style. Try not to mix more than two styles (three at most if
 you're feeling bold).



My last tip: Regardless of the trends, trust your instincts! While there are definite technical guidelines to good design, your personal style will change over time (about every 5-7 years for most people). So, buy what you love! Chances are if you stick to that rule, you can't go too terribly wrong.

INGREDIENTS

9 oz Lime Juice

24 oz Fresh Watermelon - Seedless & Juiced, Approximately Half of a Small Watermelon

1 - 2 Jalapenos - Sliced Thin, Remove Seeds for Less Spice

1 oz 100% Blue Agave

11/2 Tsp Sea Salt

1 1/2 Tsp Cayenne Pepper

2 Limes - Wedged



DIRECTIONS STEP 1

To make the watermelon juice, scoop the watermelon chunks into a blender. Once blended, you may wish to strain the seeds and excess pulp.

STEP 2

Prepare your glasses with a fun rim by mixing equal parts Salt and Cayenne Pepper (you may use Chili Pepper for less spice if preferred). Run a Lime Wedge around the rim of your glass. Dip the rim of the glass in the mixture and turn to catch the entire rim. Fill the glass with ice.

STEP 3

Combine all ingredients into the pitcher -Watermelon Juice, Lime Juice, Agave, Tequila and Jalapeno Slices. Stir thoroughly.

Pour mixture into each glass and garnish with a small watermelon slice or lime. Cheers!

PRO TIPS

Swap out the spicy rim for a sugar rim and remove the jalapenos for less spice.

No Agave? No worries! Swap out for your favorite sweetener. Simple syrup also works great.

The longer the jalapenos stay in your pitcher, the spicier your beverages may be.

The Last Guacamole Recipe You Will Ever Need!

INGREDIENTS

- 4 Avocados Peel, Pit, Mash
- 1 Red Onion Dice
- 3 Tomatoes (on the vine) Dice
- 1/2 Tsp Garlic Salt
- 1 Tsp Tsp Lemon Juice
- 1 Tbsp Tbsp Lime Juice

DIRECTIONS

In a medium bowl, combine the mashed avocados, red onion, tomatoes, lemon juice and lime juice. Add garlic salt for taste. Serve immediately with your favorite tortilla chips!



Light & Delicious Chickpea Salad

INGREDIENTS

- 16 oz Black Beans Drain & Rinse
- 16 oz Chickpeas Drain & Rinse
- 1 Cucumber Quarter
- 1 Large Avocado Peel, Pit, Dice
- 1 Green or Red Bell Pepper Dice
- 1/2 Red Onion Dice
- 1/2 cup Cherry Tomatoes Half
- 1/4 cup Olive Oil
- 2 Tbsp Red Wine Vinegar (or substitute Balsamic Vinegar)
- Salt and pepper to taste

DIRECTIONS

Combine chickpeas, black beans, cucumber, avocado, pepper, onion and tomatoes. Stir in the olive oil and add salt and pepper to taste.





INGREDIENTS

- 1/2 cup Extra Virgin Olive Oil
- 1/2 cup Balsamic Vinegar
- 1/4 cup Low Sodium Soy Sauce
- 1/8 cup Worcestershire Sauce
- 1/4 cup Pineapple Juice
- 2 tablespoons Brown Sugar
- 2 tablespoons Dijon Mustard
- 1 teaspoon Ground Black Pepper
- 2 teaspoons Garlic Powder
- 3 4 lbs Ribeye Steak

DIRECTIONS

STEP 1

Whisk all ingredients into a medium sized mixing bowl. If you have an immersion blender, use it for the fastest results.

STEP 2

Place your steaks in a sealable bag or dish, pour in the marinade and seal. Place in fridge and allow to marinade 1 to 24 hours.

STEP 3

Using a paper towel-lined plate, pat dry your steaks. Season with salt and sear on the grill. Time will depend on the thickness of your steaks.

Black Truffle Compound Butter

INGREDIENTS

- 1 Stick of Butter
- 1 Tbsp Black Truffle (minced or oil)
- 1/2 Tsp Black Pepper
- 1 Tsp Salt

DIRECTIONS

Bring butter to room temperature. Using a fork, mash all ingredients together thoroughly, until it is evenly distributed. Roll into a stick using wax paper. Refrigerate until ready to use.
